To date, the CCC has received over \$2,900

We previously discussed doing something larger in celebration of Kate and asked Dave for more information regarding the community center. There are still some hurdles and there is no specific plan yet. It could be possibly two years before the center is realized.

The CCC agrees that Kate should be recognized sooner rather than later, and that we should proceed with the original tree idea. Dave has spoken to a number of townsfolks regarding the tree and there is widespread support for having a permanent tree.

Elizabeth to reach out to Gardeners' supply to discuss what trees they have available and cost.

CCC: Land conservation Goals and discussion

Bill put together a quick list of properties he thought looked well placed for conservation. In most cases, they border already conserved lands, or are on the western end of town near the corridor that is already conserved. Also, none of these properties have structures.

Cody was put in contact with UNH cooperative extension- they run an in-depth program on how to use ArcGIS. They also offer an upcoming training. The training would be money well spent to help us with a better inventory. Would not only benefit the CCC but the town as well to assist with the town mapping. Cost around \$175, date TBD, likely in May.

Cody will reach out to ArcGIS to see if more than just the CCC could use the license. Cody will request a formal quote from ArcGIS

Len moved the CCC pay the cost of the training and license, Alice seconded. All approved, motion passed.
